10th ANNUAL YOUTH DAIRY GOAT DOE SHOW

- Dairy Goat does must be registered in the youth's or parents name or a lease agreement must be in the Youth's name. A copy of the ADGA Registration papers for each animal and/or a copy of the Lease agreement must accompany each animal entry.
- 2. Dairy Goats must be dehorned or horns tipped.
- 3. Unregistered Dairy Goat does: must show at least 50 percent Dairy Goat breed genetic traits/characteristics.
- 4. All Dairy Goat Does must be owned by January 30, 2024 or leased at least 60 days prior to show date. Entry deadline for Dairy Goat Does is January 30, 2024. Entries should be mailed to:

- 5. Newborn Dairy Goat doe kids born after January 30, 2024 are eligible to show in the 0-3 month. This is the only exception for late entry into the Dairy Goat Doe show. Contact the Dairy Goat Superintendent to complete these entries by March 1, 2024. Due to late entry, these animals may not appear in the GCA & NRYO Exhibitor program.
- 6. Entries may be shown with either halter or show chain.
- 7. Dairy Goat Doe class order will be determined by the superintendent and board after registration ends according to entries submitted.
- 8. Youth must participate in Showmanship and must use a Dairy Goat doe exhibited in a Quality class as defined above.

- 9. Animals will be eligible for auction/sale at the owner's discretion.
- 10. Standardized record books will be available online. These record books are to be shown to the show superintendent on March 22, 2024 for signature.

 The completed record book will be due by April 2, 2024 at the extension office no later than 4:30pm or at the 4-H show barn between 5:30-6:00pm.
