8th ANNUAL YOUTH DAIRY GOAT DOE SHOW

1. Dairy Goat does must be registered in the youth's name or a Lease agreement must be in the Youth's name. A copy of the ADGA Registration papers for each animal and/or a copy of the Lease agreement must accompany each animal entry. Omission of these papers will forfeit the entry.
2. Dairy Goats must be dehorned.
3. For unregistered Dairy Goat does: Eligible to show in the Commercial class but must show at least 50 percent Dairy Goat genetic traits/characteristics.
4. Newborn Dairy Goat doe kids born after January 30, 2022 are eligible to show in the 0-3 month. This is the only exception for late entry into the Dairy Goat Doe show. Contact the Dairy Goat Superintendent to complete these entries by March 1, 2022. Due to late entry, these animals may not appear in the GCA & NRYO Exhibitor program.
5. Dairy Goat Doe Show Quality class order will be determined by breeds as recommended by the Florida State ADGA:
 - (1) Commercial/Unregistered/Grade
 - (2) Registered: Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Toggenburg, Oberhasli, Saanen, Sables, Alpines, LaMancha, all other breeds.
6. Youth must participate in Showmanship and must use a Dairy Goat doe exhibited in a Quality class as defined above.
7. Animals will be eligible for auction/sale at the owner's discretion.
8. Classes will be finalized after entry deadline date and/or March 1, 2022 as determined by the Superintendent.
